

9. JOLLY PHONICS TRAINING

Jolly Phonics is a comprehensive phonics program designed for early childhood education. It teaches the children the essential skills of letter sounds, blending, segmenting, tricky words and handwriting practice, building a strong foundation for literacy development. The aim of the Jolly Phonics method is to develop English literacy skills in young learners.

The Management (SRI VIJAY VIDYALAYA GROUP OF INSTITUTIONS) organized Jolly Phonics Training for the staff of Kindergarten and Grade 1 & 2 on 27.7.2024 and 28.7.2024 (Time: 8.30 am to 5.30 pm) in THE VIJAY MILLENNIUM SENIOR SECONDARY SCHOOL, KRISHNAGIRI.

- Letter sounds (Seven Groups)
- Blends (blending with simple three letter words)
- Tricky words
- Story narration
- Cozy corner
- Consonants
- Short vowel sounds
- More complex consonant combinations and bump up to four letter words.
- Kung-Fu punctuations
- Vowel combinations-ea,oo,ai

The staff were divided into ten groups and each group was given a chance to do the activities like Kung-Fu Punctuations, enacting the story, letter sounds of Cc – Kk, phonics sounds/songs of each letter, etc. The trainer took the total control over the program and was very polite and kind enough to teach the concepts. The staff were very much enthralled in participating in the activities. Before the program could end, the Principals and the staff from each school were asked to give their valuable feedback of the program and the trainer. The feedback form was distributed to everyone to get to know how the session went. In the end, Jolly Phonics certificates were distributed to the staff by the trainer. Our respected Senior Principal took his invaluable time thanking the trainer, heads and the teachers for making the days a big hit.
